Continuing Snow Removal Operations at Fort Meade

Fort Meade, Maryland, February 11, 2010 –

Picerne's staff is making every effort to clear the neighborhood streets and sidewalks as quickly as possible considering the massive snowfall from back-to-back storms in the last several days.

All Neighborhood Offices at Fort Meade are open today until 6 p.m. and will resume normal hours of operation—8 a.m. to 6 p.m.—tomorrow, February 12, 2010.

Residents are asked to avoid walking on road edges as much as possible. There were reports of numerous close calls, especially along Mapes Road. Cars should be parked safely and in such a manner that there is still room for other cars and snow removal vehicles to pass. Cars creating a hazard may be ticketed and towed.

Neighborhood trash collection will resume tomorrow. Residents with a scheduled collection day for Wednesday or Thursday should expect their garbage to be picked up tomorrow, February 12th. Residents that experienced a delay in trash pick-up due to the weather should expect their garbage to be collected on Saturday, February 13th. Picerne's contractor, Allied Waste Services, will only be picking up trash, not recyclables, on Thursday and Friday. Garbage and recycling collection will resume a normal schedule beginning next week.
